

Minutes of a meeting of Lupton Parish Council held at Kittridding Tea Rooms on Monday 1st August 2022 at 7.30pm.

22/21 Public participation:

The following application was considered:

SL/2022/0630 The Barn, Thompson Fold, Lupton. Demolition of barn and erection of 3 dwellings with associated works (following previous prior approval under Class Q  ref: CU/2020/0007).

The Council supports the proposed demolition of the barn and, in principle, is happy with the application. However, it is believed that amended plans are in hand, that as yet have not been seen. When these are available, further comment will be made.

- b. It was agreed to follow up the possibility of installing three defibrillators in the parish, and applying for grants to assist in this.
